

# Terms & Conditions for parent-child classes 2021



## Gymboree opening times

Gymboree is open for parent-child classes from the 5<sup>th</sup> of January to the 26<sup>th</sup> of June 2021. There are no classes on the following public holidays: Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Monday 5<sup>th</sup> of April incl. (Easter weekend), Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> of May (Assumption) and Monday 24<sup>th</sup> of May (Pentecost).

## Weekly Enrolment

Enrolment is for one or more classes per week over 12 or 24 weeks or for the number of weeks remaining until the 26<sup>th</sup> of June 2021 except when Gymboree is closed (please see above), these dates are not billed.

## Registration fee

There is a unique registration fee of CHF 100.00 valid for all siblings, for life and at participating international locations. This fee defrays the cost of processing membership paperwork and allows you two free classes at another Gymboree as well as a 10% discount on our birthday parties for children aged 1 to 5 years.

## Discounts

Discounts are per child, are not cumulative and are on the lesser amount:

- 10% for new members when you sign up on the day of your free preview class
- 10% on a back to back enrolment (the first class on the new enrolment follows the week after the end of the previous enrolment)
- 30 % on a second class per week for the same child
- 20% on a sibling enrolling for the same period as his brother or sister.

## Refunds

You can apply for a refund by writing with a 4 week notice period. No refund is given on the membership fee. Any bank fees are at the charge of the customer.

## Missed classes

Any missed classes can be made-up during the enrolment period by coming to any other age appropriate class where there is space. No extensions will be made to an enrolment for missed classes due to illness, holidays or any other reason.

## Play times

During the validity of your enrolment your child and any sibling under the age of 5 years old have unlimited access to our play times. This is a time for children and parents to explore our unique play equipment.

## Socks on the play floor

For hygiene reasons adults must wear socks on the play floor. Please bring a pair with you. Children should ideally be barefoot as their toes are needed for balance and grip.

## Sickness

For the consideration of all, please do not bring a sick child to class. If your child is not feeling well, please book in for a make-up class.

## Siblings

Babies under the age of 6 months can be brought to class with an enrolled sibling but must be in a baby carrier or a baby chair. For safety reasons and so you and your child can fully enjoy this special time together, non-enrolled siblings over the age of 6 months cannot be brought to class, please ask about our family class.

## Parent liability

Parents accept the responsibility for assuring that each child is at all times accompanied and supervised by at least one adult.

## Parent participation

Gymboree classes follow a structured form and are designed to enhance your child's physical, cognitive, social and emotional development. To maximize the benefits, we ask all parents to follow the teacher's lead and encourage their child to participate in the class activities. Parents are important role models and children are more motivated when supported by someone they trust who celebrates their achievements.

## Pictures

You are allowed to take pictures and films of your child at Gymboree however please do not take pictures or films of any other child or adult without their permission.

## Privacy

Gymboree values you as a customer and respects your privacy. We will not sell, share or rent your personally identifiable information to any third party.
